Description	In 2004 the Jack Kent Cooke Foundation made three substantial changes to its graduate program. 1) The Graduate Program is now a national competition, accepting nominations from universities across the U.S. 2) Students must be nominated by their colleges. 3) Recent graduates are now eligible. Nominees may be drawn from students who have graduated with in the last five years as well as the present class of seniors. Applicants must have UNMET financial need for graduate study. A minimum GPA of 3.5 or above is required. US citizenship is NOT required.
Award	Approximately 35 awards will be made for graduate study; they provide funding for tuition, room and board, required fees, and books for up to six years of graduate study. Awards cannot exceed \$50,000 annually.
