

## Ford Foundation: Predoctoral Fellowships for Minorities

Award Type	Graduate Study
Eligibility	US Citizens; only certain minorities are eligible. Must have completed degree requirements
Class Eligibility	Graduate Only
Academic Area	Computer Science, Mathematics, Engineering, Physics, Astronomy, Earth Sciences, Chemistry, Life Sciences, Social Sciences, History, Philosophy, Religion, Literature, Language, Humanities, Psychology

Description	To increase the presence of underrepresented minorities on the nation's college and university faculties, to enhance diversity on campuses, and to address the persisting effects of past discrimination, the Ford Foundation offers predoctoral fellowships to members of six minority groups whose under representation in the professoriate has been severe and long-standing. Awards will be made for study in research-based Ph.D. or Sc.D. programs in selected academic disciplines. A comprehensive list of eligible fields of study is listed on the program website. Individuals enrolled in practice-oriented programs will not be supported.
Award	\$16,000 to the Fellow, institutional allowance of \$7,500 for three years; All awardees have expenses paid to attend the Conference of Ford Fellows for three years.
