Eligibility	Must be US citizen, national or permanent resident alien of the US.

Description	The NSF offers approximately 900 graduate fellowships each year, including awards for women in engineering and computer and information science. Fellowships provide 3 years of support for graduate study leading to research-based master's or doctoral degrees in the fields of science, mathematics, and engineering supported by the NSF, and are intended for students in the early stages of their graduate study.
Award	3 years of support that may be used over a 5-year period. Funding includes a \$21,500 stipend for a 12-month tenure, plus \$10,500 cost-of-education allowance per tenure year; however, an increase in stipend is expected.
