Description	<p>The Paul & Daisy Soros Fellowships for New Americans provides opportunities for able and accomplished New Americans to achieve leadership in their chosen fields. A New American is an individual who (1) is a resident alien; i.e., holds a Green Card or, (2) has been naturalized as a U.S. citizen or (3) is the child of two parents who are both naturalized citizens. The applicant must either have a bachelor's degree or be in her/his final year of undergraduate study. Those who have a bachelor's degree may already be pursuing graduate study and may receive Fellowship support to continue that study. All subjects of study are eligible at any university in the U.S.</p>
Award	A maintenance grant of \$20,000 (paid in two installments) and tuition grant of one-half the tuition cost of the U.S. graduate program attended by the Fellow.
