Description	Each year, the Udall Foundation awards undergraduate scholarships on the basis of merit to TWO groups of students: 1. Those who are college sophomores or juniors in the current academic year, have outstanding potential, and who study the environment and related fields. 2. Native American and Alaska Native students who are college sophomores or juniors in the current academic year, have outstanding potential, and are in fields related to health care or tribal public policy. Two-year and four-year institutions are eligible to nominate a total of six students from either or both categories. To be considered, a student must be nominated by his or her university. The scholarship funds may be used to pay for tuition, fees, books, room and board. Udall Scholars also attend a special workshop during the summer.
